- 2) Applicant **MUST** submit two letters of reference by faculty at their school
- 3) Applicant **MUST** attend the Arcolian Christmas Party to receive the award
- 4) Scholarship winner agrees to facilitate hosting one lunch-and-learn event in a given year sponsored and paid for by the Arcolians to educate and encourage students to participate and learn about the organization

Applicants will additionally have 3 of the following criteria

1. Active in school extracurricular activities
2. Published author (articles, periodicals, journals)
3. Philanthropic (time, effort, money)
4. Outstanding ethical and moral character
5. Community service
6. Catholic
7. Active Arcolian Student Member
